### 288.3. Matters Arising

#### a). Police Matters. Steve gave the report: -

There have been cases of fly tipping in the area including old tyres by Dronley Wood. Report any evidence of tipping to Tayside Police on 101 (this is the new non emergency number)

Beware of bogus calls. Some people, including elderly, have been caught out by visitors offering services which don't materialise and never see their money again.

Look out for your neighbours during this wintry weather, especially the elderly, and give any help needed.

#### c). TACTRAN / STPR/NFF2.

There is nothing to report on TACTRAN & STPR. Currently rail improvements are receiving priority.

The authors of the National Planning Framework have acknowledged the error in NPF2 (*the project to upgrade the A90 was listed simply as a project to install a Northern Bypass of Dundee without mention of the option of upgrading the Kingsway*). This will be corrected in NPF3
