

Report on Hall Committee meeting January 2013

The quarterly meeting of the Hall Committee was able to test the new sound system which can be used for all meetings. Some issues were identified including an echo which proved troublesome. These will be ironed out in due course but it is hoped that this purchase will benefit all those who have difficulty hearing or being heard.

It was noted with great disappointment that at two public events – the Children’s Christmas Party and the Burns Supper, the outside lights failed to work. Even the Christmas tree lights were off but that was not a fault - just someone inadvertently switching off the time clock. The Hall Committee apologise for this inconvenience and trust it did not affect the enjoyment of the events.

A debate then followed on the division of responsibility for such issues between Angus Council and us – the Management Committee of the Hall. The Council had contracted a firm to undertake a number of repairs but concern was expressed at the length of time this was taking. It was agreed that I should have a discussion with Mr. Ferguson, the Head Teacher, as a step towards resolving our concerns.

The decision was taken to purchase good second hand chairs from Tayside Recyclers to replace some worn ones.

The next meeting is the AGM to be held on April 25th 2013.
